

CONCLUSION PARAGRAPH ORGANIZER

In the conclusion paragraph, you need to draw upon new ideas about your Attention Getter; wrap up the paper so that it is finished.

Here are the steps:

1. Restate, but do not repeat, your thesis statement. Connect to your initial motivation/curiosities for writing the paper in the first place.
2. Connect your thesis ideas and what you revealed in your essay to your introductory Attention Getter.
3. End with a new question, thought, or idea relating to your Attention Getter and the findings you unfolded in the essay.
